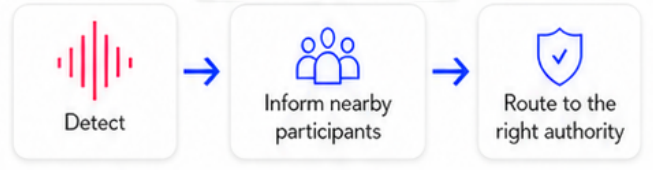

### Common concerns with fixed infrastructure systems

### What supporters value in fixed infrastructure systems

-  Concentrated in certain neighborhoods
-  Can deepen over-policing concerns
-  Alerts may stay inside police channels
-  Fixed infrastructure can be costly and inflexible

-  Fast notification when 911 calls are delayed
-  Earlier awareness may help save lives
-  Can speed response to likely gunfire locations
-  May surface incidents that otherwise go unreported



-   Opt in and community centered
-   In people's hands, not only fixed infrastructure
-   Privacy-first, smartphone-based approach
-   Deploy by ward, park, corridor, event, or neighborhood
-   Helps route alerts through trusted local channels
